Harry Goemans Garden Centre is a family-run nursery situated on Kommetjie Road in Sunnydale. Harry Goemans came to South Africa from Holland and in 1960 opened the nursery for trading on Main Road, Bergvliet. Harry's son-in-law, Henry Fenn, started the Sunnydale branch in 1994. Jeremy, Henry's son, now manages the garden centre.

This nursery caters for your every gardening need, from quality plants, to tools, to soils and garden décor.

The nursery stocks a large range of indigenous plants and fynbos, culinary herbs and lavenders, as well as colourful and hardy garden plants. You will always find the garden center well-stocked up on organic fertilizers (such as bat guano, kelp products and chicken manure products), and natural pesticides for maintaining the ecological balance of insects and wildlife in your garden.

A pretty tea garden, The Wild Camphor, is set amongst the plants with the soothing sound of running water nearby. The tea garden offers home-made dishes and other eats, and with the jungle gym nearby you can leave the kids to play while you browse for your newest addition to the garden.
